



System Training and Response (STaR) Team

Limiting Average Daily Membership (ADM)

- Students with more than 1 membership and no JTED Satellite membership involved, where the total ADM for the student is greater than 1.0 shall be limited proportionally to the maximum of 1.0.
- Students with more than 1 membership and at least 1 JTED Satellite membership involved, where the total ADM is greater than 1.25 shall be limited proportionally to the maximum of 1.25.
- Students with a JTED Main membership shall be excluded from the concurrency/subsequent membership processing. ADM calculations shall be based on the membership submitted FTE multiplied by the total membership days.
- District/District and Charter/Charter memberships are excluded from limiting as long as the following rules are met:

No District/Charter memberships whether subsequent or concurrent exist within the student's membership history for the fiscal year being processed.

AND

No TAPBI membership exists, either via subsequent enrollment or concurrency, within the student's membership history for the fiscal year being processed.

Limited Membership Days (LIM Memb Days) is calculated by multiplying the membership days accrued at a single school, times the number of days in the period, times the ADM limit, divided by the total membership days generated by all schools during the period

$$\frac{\text{Membership Days} \times \text{Days in Period} \times \text{ADM Limit}}{\text{Total Membership Days Generated during Period}}$$

Limited Average Daily Membership (LIM ADM) is calculated by dividing Limited Membership Days by days in the reporting period.

$$\frac{\text{LIM Memb Days}}{\text{Days in Reporting Period}}$$
