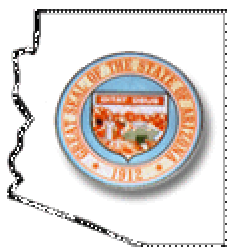

SUBJECT: New Version of Delrep

We have modified the Vehicle Inventory section in Delrep to allow for 7 character license plate numbers. If you will be using Delrep to complete your vehicle inventory, you need to download the latest version of Delrep. We have also corrected problems in older versions of Delrep, so you might want to download the newest version for this reason.

You may download the latest version of Delrep, which is Delrep2.97.3, by clicking on "Delrep Update File" from ADE's Web site:

This "update.exe" will copy your old Delrep files to a backup directory C:\DELSAVE3 and install Delrep2.97.3

If you have never used Delrep, you may want to download the full run-time version of Delrep, "Delrep2_97_3.exe", by clicking on "Delrep Program Files".

If you have an Access 2000 run-time on your computer, you would need to download "Delrep2000-May172000-Distribution.exe" by clicking on "Delrep2.2000.3 Self-extracting archive file". AFTER you have backed up your present DelrepW to a backup folder, run this exe.

If you do not have an Internet connection, you can obtain this latest version from the RTC's. We also have a limited number of CD-ROM's with the latest version of Delrep on it. You may receive one of these by faxing a request to David Schuricht at (602) 542-3099 or mailing it to ADE. Please include your CTDS number, contact person, mailing address, and phone number.

You will notice that 4 sections of Delrep have been disabled. That is because graduation rate, School District Employee Report, and transportation route reporting systems will be created directly on the School Finance Web site beginning in the fall of 2000 as mentioned in School Finance Memo 00-055.
